

"Welcome to the Village of Red Hook"

We are happy to "welcome you" to the Village of Red Hook. Below are some Rules & Regulations concerning residents who reside in the Village

1. For those who have purchased a home in the Village you can purchase garbage stickers at the Village Hall for your garbage pick-up. Large tags (30gal.) are \$5.00 each and small tags (10gal.) are \$2.50 each.

Garbage & Recycling pick-up is every Monday at 6:00 am, with the exception of holidays. Recycling is free with the purchase of Village garbage stickers. Comingle is to be placed curbside in a proper plastic bin – comingle is not permitted curbside in plastic bags or cardboard boxes.

Garbage stickers may also be purchased at Mac's Agway.

2. Water bills are mailed quarterly - (January, April, July & October)
3. No burning of garbage or brush is permitted in the Village of Red Hook. BBQ's are permitted.
4. There is a leash law in the Village. No dog is allowed off your property unless contained by a leash and dog feces must be discarded by the dog owner.
5. Village taxes are due in June of each year. School taxes are due in September, land and county taxes are due in February.
6. Village snow ordinance is in effect from November 1st through March 31st. During this time there is no street parking permitted between the hours of 11:00pm – 6:00am. All residents must keep sidewalks clear of all snow, ice and debris. Please shovel all fire hydrants of snow and ice.
7. Zoning is in effect. Pools, decks, additions and any change of construction requires a building permit and some planning board approval. The Zoning office is located at the Village Hall. Zoning Hours are Monday and Wednesday 11:00am – 4:00pm.
8. The Village of Red Hook POLICE DEPARTMENT is now dispatching through the New York State Police and the non-emergency contact number is 758-0060. Please remember in an emergency DIAL 911.

The Red Hook Police Department offers security checks to residents who are away from their home. A security check form is available at the Village Hall.

9. The Village Court is located at the Village Hall. Court is held every 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month. The Village Court telephone number is: 845-758-4113. Hon. Jonah Triebwasser and Court Clerk Kathy Fell.
10. The Village of Red Hook has brush and leaf pick-up each Spring and Fall.
11. There is a landfill available for Village residents only. You may purchase a landfill permit at the Village Hall for \$20.00. The Landfill is to be used for yard debris only. No household garbage or lumber of any kind is permitted. The Landfill is open on Saturday from 9:00am – 2:00pm.

12. **Senior Citizens, Star Exemptions and Veterans Exemptions should be applied for at the Tax Assessor's office located at the Town of Red Hook, Town Hall, 7340 South Broadway, Red Hook (845-758-4604).**
13. **The Village Hall hours are Monday – Friday – 9:00am – 4:00pm, with the exception of holidays.**
14. **We require that any resident selling or moving from the Village please notify the Village Hall for a final water reading. Our office must be advised with the new owners name and address for future water billing mailings.**
15. **The Village of Red Hook Building is a drop-off location for donations for "Hugs From Home". Local Citizens Sending Care Packages to our Troops. Shipment is on the 15th of Each Month

16. **There is NO tree pruning permitted in the Village right-of-ways.**
17. **Residents interested in donating scrap metal can contact Highway Superintendent, Dan Streib, at 845-758-8600 or Village Trustee, Brenk Kovalchik at 845-758-1081 to arrange for pick-up. All proceeds from the sale of scrap metal will be used to purchase equipment for the Village of Red Hook Highway and Waste Recovery Departments.**
18. ***With Spring approaching, please consider composting in your own yard. Household waste contains a lot of vegetable matter that can easily compost and be used around your plants and gardens. Shop locally and buy an easy to use bin and help the planet. Red Hook would like to move further toward Zero Waste, meaning most everything gets recycled.***
